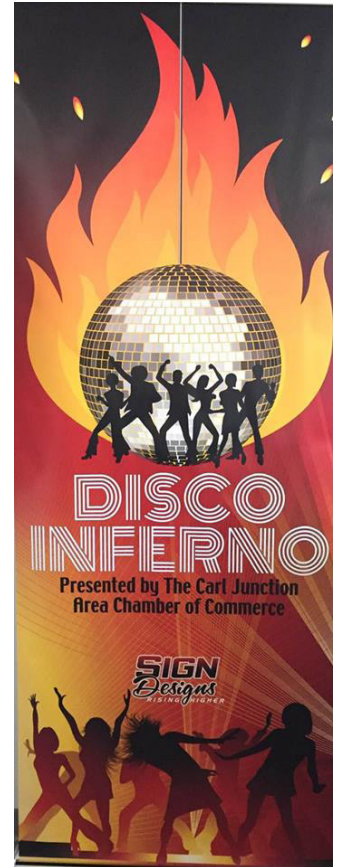
## 19th Annual Awards Banquet Slated

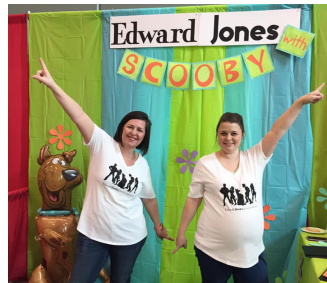

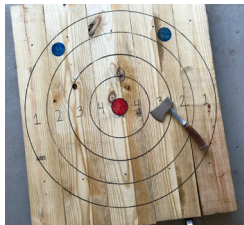
### 3rd Annual Golf Tournament
